

Government and Agriculture – where are we currently?

- BPS last year to activate Entitlements.
- The 2024 to 2027 payments will be based on claims in reference period from 2019-2021
- 2023 Payments will be made in two parts again July and December.
- Cross Compliance is active currently but ends on 31st December 2023 after 18 years.

Government general direction.

- Make agriculture more efficient
- Adopt Regenerative principles
- Use Capital Grants to stimulate specific areas
- Happy for Agriculture to be supported to sequester carbon and also enter private carbon schemes.



BUT In Reality

- More bureaucracy and sophisticated way to get money from government.
- A single BPS claim was more straightforward
- SFI will be much more bespoke to individual farm circumstances.
- More record keeping
- Businesses more prepared for this system will make it pay.

Hedgerows

Assess and record condition £3 per 100m one side

Manage hedgerow for variety of width and height $$\pm 10 \ \text{per } 100 \text{m}$$ one side

Maintain hedge to have at least 1 tree per 100m £10 per 100m both sides



Integrated Pest Management (IPM)

Complete an Integrated Pest Management Assessment and produce IPM Plan £989 per year

Establish flower – rich grass margins blocks or in field strips £673 per ha

Establish a companion crop £55 per ha

No insecticide use £45 per ha

Nutrient Management

Complete a Nutrient Management Assessment (NM) and produce a NM report £589 per year

Establish and maintain legumes £102 per ha

Establish a legume fallow £593 per ha



Agricultural and Horticultural Land

Establish and maintain a pollen and nectar flower mix £614 per ha

Establish and maintain winter bird food £732 per ha

Establish and maintain grassy field corners £590 per ha

Establish and maintain 4 - 12m buffer strip £451 per ha

Improved Grassland

Take field corners and blocks out of management £333 per ha

Maintain improved grassland for winter bird food £474 per ha

Establish and maintain a 4m to 12m buffer strip £235 per ha



Low Input Grassland

Manage grass with very low inputs (outside SDA) £151 per ha

Manage grass with very low nutrient inputs (SDA) £98 per ha
